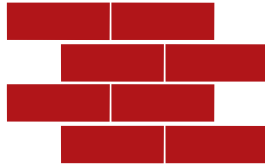


CO-DOUGH SALT DOUGH CREATIONS

MATERIALS FOR 1 CREATION:

- 1 Cup All Purpose Flour
- ½ Cup Salt
- ½ Water - Room Temperature
- Mixing Bowl
- Measuring Cups
- Parchment Paper
- Plastic Knife
- Paint
- Paint Brush
- Wooden Mixing Spoon
- Doodads for Decorations (buttons, beads, etc. - optional)



DIRECTIONS:

First, mix the ingredients.

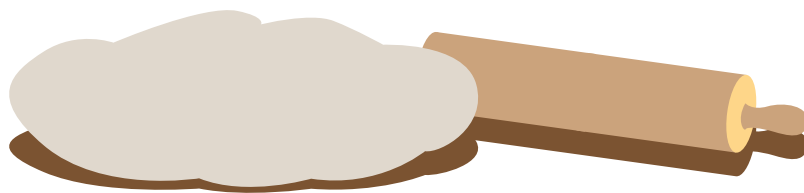
1. Put flour in the mixing bowl. Add the salt and then the water.
2. Mix with the wooden spoon.

Next, prepare the dough.

4. This is a great project to do with a friend. In fact, we call this dough co-dough because cooperating with a friend to prepare the dough can be so much fun!
5. Knead the dough until it feels like clay. If the dough is sticky add a little bit of flour. If the dough is dry add a little bit of water.
6. If you want to make a flat shape, roll out the dough.

Finally, put it all together!

7. Using your plastic knife cut out a shape or manipulate the dough into a shape.
8. You can add buttons, beads, and other doodads as decoration while the dough is soft.
9. The dough takes about 2 days to air dry. Be patient!
10. Optional: Ask an adult to dry your creation in a microwave. **WARNING:** Do not put your creation in a microwave if you used any buttons, beads or other doodads as decorations.
11. When dry, paint your shape.
12. Have fun!
