

NO-BAKE TREE BARK RECIPE

In the story **MOTH & SLOTH: Best Friends Forever**, Moth lives in Sloth's fur and helps create algae that camouflages Sloth from predators. The algae helps Sloth blend into moss-covered tree bark. We're going to make our own delicious tree bark with green "moss" so Sloth can hide.

INGREDIENTS

- 2 Tablespoons Nutella
 - ¼ Cup of Peanuts
 - ¼ Cup of Broken Pretzels
 - 1 Tablespoons Shredded & Sweetened Coconut
 - 2 Drops of Green Food Coloring
- Aluminum Foil
Note: Substituting "mix-ins" works well.

DIRECTIONS

First, make the "moss".

Add 2 two drops of food coloring to the coconut.
Mix together until most of the coconut is green.
Set aside

Next...mix, mix, mix.

Scoop the Nutella into a bowl
Add your mix-in's and mix, mix, mix.

Finally, put it all together!

Line cookie sheet with foil
Spread the Nutella mixture on the foil in any shape
Sprinkle the "moss" mixture
Freeze for 2-4 hours
The Nutella will harden when it freezes.
Break off pieces of the bark and enjoy it with a friend!
