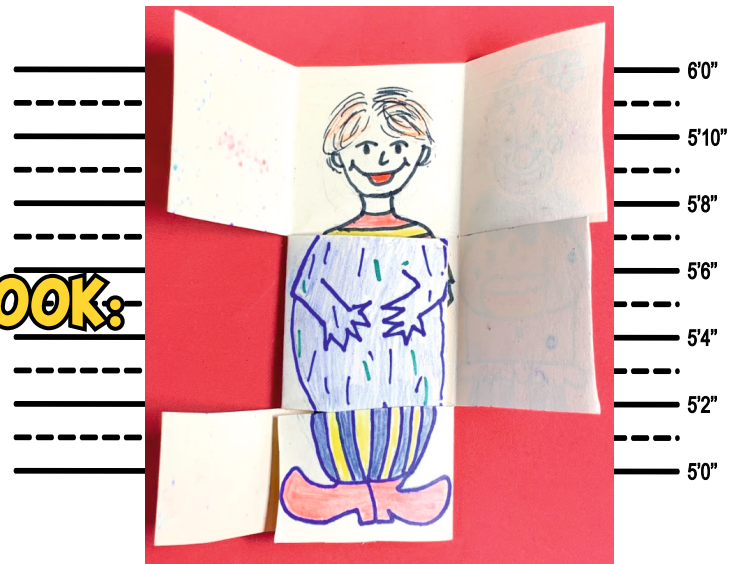


MIX UP BOOK



MATERIALS FOR 1 MIX UP BOOK:

- 1 Piece of Cardstock (or $\frac{1}{2}$ of a file folder or 1 sheet of plain paper)
- 1 Pencil with Eraser for Drawing
- 1 Markers, Colored Pencils, Crayons

DIRECTIONS:

First, fold the paper.

1. Holding the paper horizontally, fold into thirds.
2. On the outer edge of the first panel, make a cut towards the center panel about $\frac{1}{3}$ from the top stopping at the center panel fold. Make another cut towards the center about $\frac{1}{3}$ from the bottom stopping at the center panel fold. Make matching cuts on the third panel.

Next, draw your figures.

3. Choose any 3 figures that you want to draw. Just make sure you will be able to line up the body parts.
4. Use a pencil to draw a figure in the middle (uncut) panel.
5. Fold over the top third of the first panel. Draw the top third of your next figure lining up the body parts. Fold in the middle part and continue drawing again lining up the body parts. Fold in the bottom part and draw in the bottom of your figure. Unfold.
6. Repeat the process to draw the third figure in the third panel.
7. Check that you like how the different thirds line up. Make whatever adjustments you think are needed.

Finally, put it all together!

8. Color in each figure and have fun with your MIX UP Book!
